Charcoal:

Nitram Charcoal is some of the best out there. They sell it in packs of 5 sticks, so it tends to be more costly. But worth the price.

Windsor & Newton makes a good quality **vine** charcoal. Get a box of soft, 12 or 24 sticks.

Kneaded Eraser

White rubber erase

Sanding block

Masking tape / painters tape

Charcoal Paper: I use Canson Mi-Tients, it comes in a variety of colors. I use white or pearl grey. Buy a few sheets.

There are other papers also, like fabriano Roma, tough to find. There's Rives paper that can be good. In general, paper that has some tooth, roughness, and isn't very soft, meaning more rigid paper is better.
